

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES ON
SNOW OR INCLEMENT WEATHER CLOSURE
DAYS**Board Policy**

The safety of students is the overriding consideration on those occasions when schools are closed due to inclement weather. The Board of Trustees of the Shelley Joint School District No. 60 therefore wants careful and comprehensive thought and discussion prior to making any decision to hold athletic or other practices or competition or performances on days or evening when school has been closed.

Suggested Implementation Guidelines

The following will assist in making a decision.

- A. Athletic Practices – Practices may only be called after discussion between the head coach and the building principal.
 - 1. Significant improvement in the weather conditions since the decision to close school should be noted.
 - 2. If a practice is scheduled, any student missing the practice will not be penalized, as attendance is optional as determined by the parent.
- B. Athletic Contests – An already scheduled athletic contest may be held if:
 - 1. The severe weather conditions have abated.
 - 2. Both school district administration and coaching personnel agree to continue the contest.
 - 3. There is an expected safety level anticipated by contest time.
- C. Other School Activities – Drama, Music, Art or other performances may be held consistent with the provisions under “B” above.
