

Board Policy

Any student being promoted from the 7th grade to the 8th grade or 8th grade to 9th grade must have completed all requirements established by the Shelley Joint School District No. 60 and the State of Idaho.

Suggested implementation Guidelines

- A. The Following definitions apply:
1. Middle School Education: Includes grades seven (7) and eight (8).
 2. Semester Credit: A semester credit in a secondary school is a course that meets one period for one semester.
- B. The following criteria are required of all students in order for them to be promoted in The Shelley School District Middle School Program.
1. Credits
 - a) Middle School education shall be measured in semester credits. Credits shall be granted as follows:
Semester Credit (Semester course) 1 credit
 - b) To be promoted in The Shelley School District Middle School Program, beginning in grade 7 students must pass 80% of the courses they are enrolled in and not fail a full year of any core subject. Core subjects are defined as English, Math, Social Studies, and Science.
 - c) Students must attend class 90% of the time.
 2. Alternate Route to Promotion
 - a) Students must receive credit in non passed courses in The Shelley School District Middle School Summer Program, IDLA, I Succeed, Idaho Virtual Academy, or any other **accredited** summer school program. Documentation of Summer School completion must submitted before the beginning of the next school year.
