Free Tutoring – Supplemental Educational Services (SES)

Some schools that are in school improvement year two, corrective action or restructuring offer students the opportunity to receive extra tutoring (at no cost to the parent) called supplemental educational services (SES). This tutoring is outside of school hours.

Students from Stuart Elementary School and Hobbs Middle School who are eligible for free or reduced-price lunch can apply for free tutoring. If funds are not available to serve all students who are eligible, we must give priority to the lowest-achieving eligible students.
