

SEVERE WEATHER

Board Policy

The Shelley Joint School District No. 60 is to be prepared with an action plan to be implemented during severe weather conditions which require students in the buildings prior to normal hours and allowing students to remain in the building during scheduled recesses and lunch breaks.

Suggested Implementation Guidelines

The following guidelines are to protect students as per this policy.

1. During severe weather conditions, students will be allowed into the school buildings as soon as the first bus is scheduled to arrive.
 - a. Supervision will be provided for lower elementary-aged students.
2. Students will not be required to leave the school building during the school day for recess or other breaks on days when the temperature, including the wind chill factor, is zero degrees Fahrenheit to lower.
 - a. The temperature is to be determined on information provided by the computerized weather station installed at the district's maintenance shop.
3. Each building principal shall establish and implement those procedures to assure safety and supervision of students as determined to be needed based on the maturity and age of the students.
